ABOUT

The Pannónia Scholarship Programme offers both short and long-term mobilities for Hungarian higher education students and staff to study, research, teach, or do traineeships abroad in every country of the world at leading universities! It also offers exchange opportunities for staff members from partner institutions.

The Hungarian Government's scholarship programme provides opportunities for Hungarian higher education institutions to establish meaningful international partnerships with leading higher education institutions and legal entities (training and research centres, public and private organizations, etc.) through bilateral agreements. The programme is coordinated by the Hungarian National Agency, Tempus Public Foundation.

BACKGROUND

The programme was developed in partnership with Hungarian universities to strengthen international relations in the higher education sector. It is similar to the Erasmus+ Programme as a lump-sum grant is provided to the model-changed universities that can be used from 1st June 2024 to implement student, teacher, researcher and staff mobilities and teacher exchanges on the basis of new bilateral contracts.

The Hungarian Government is committed to reach 20,000 outgoing mobilities until 2030, and this can only be achieved if more funding is allocated to the higher education sector. As the Council Implementing Decision is still in effect, it was imperative to provide outgoing mobility opportunities to the model-changed universities. As a consequence of the Council Decision, 21 Hungarian universities, which comprise 60% of students and staff of the Hungarian higher education sector, are limited in international mobility.

STUDY TYPES

Student mobility

- Long-term student mobility: Study period or traineeship (2-12 months), and research (2-3 months).
- Short-term student mobility: Study period or research (2-30 days), conferences, and summer universities.
- Excellence Programme: High-achieving students in specific fields of study can do their mobility at one of the top 250 universities in the world.

Staff mobility

- For teachers, researchers and university staff
- Training period, teaching period, or research (2-60 days).
- In addition to the outgoing mobility, Hungarian higher education institutions have the possibility to provide teachers scholarships for incoming short-term mobility

PROVISIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT *

- Long-term student mobility grants range from HUF 350,000 to 400,000 per month
- Short-term student mobility grants range from HUF 5,000 to HUF 35,000 per day
- Excellence Programme grants range from HUF 450,000 to 500,000 per month
- Staff grants range from HUF 16,500 to HUF 70,000 per day

^{*}The amount depends on the type and destination of the mobility and may include additional allowances, such as tuition fee compensation and social grant for people with fewer opportunities.
